#### Schedule

Payment plans for tuition are available to be worked out between student and director.

#### **Confidential Morals Questionnaire**

A past problem in this area does not necessarily disqualify you, provided: (1) it can be determined that convictions are strong and consistent with Scripture, and (2) <u>a sufficient, time-tested record of victory has been established</u> . The information that you share with us will be treated confidentially and will be seen only by those directly involved in your application decision. As stated previously, only staff of the same gender will read this portion of your application.
