7 Place

There is only one hope that overcomes the pain of this world. A hope anchored beyond the veil of life and death. If we are to follow Jesus through this life of joy and sorrow, the hope of heaven is essential.

Hoping in what you cannot see

Every time I go on vacation I like to look up pictures of the place where we'll stay or the things we'll do. I like to ask people who have gone before what they enjoyed and what they would recommend that we do. It helps me get excited for what's to come. We don't have these opportunities when it comes to looking forward to heaven. We have to place our hope completely in trusting Jesus.

Read

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.

John 14:1-3

Hebrews 12 says that "for the joy set before Him, Jesus endured the Cross." Jesus' ability to endure the suffering of the cross came because of the joy he knew he would have in heaven. In the gospel of John, Jesus invites us into this same hope.

Paul says without the hope of Heaven we are to be pitied beyond all people, because the life we are asked to live is self sacrificing. To follow Jesus is to completely trust Him that he has gone to prepare a place for us and he will come again. It's worth it!!

Preparing for Heaven
